We did have a wet start to the club roll-up sessions but the weather has been reasonably kind to us whilst we have been playing matches against other clubs. High winds and an abundance of sunshine has, however, taken its toll on the green and we are now experiencing several dry patches. Luckily, as a sports facility, we are allowed to water the green at certain times of the day despite the hosepipe ban in Kent.

We have been very fortunate in gaining more new members to the club this year. Most were completely new to bowling but, following coaching sessions with Vicki, several have now become welcome additions to our teams and are regular players in our friendly matches and our league matches against other clubs.

**The Mermaid Fling -** Many of you will be aware that clubs competing in the Mermaid League take turns in hosting an annual tournament known as the Mermaid Fling. It is our turn to run the tournament this year on **Sunday 2nd July.** That's this Sunday coming! A lot of effort has already gone into the organisation of the day but we still need more volunteers on the day itself helping out with a variety of tasks (making lunches, serving drinks, cakes and savoury snacks, running raffles and other fund-raising competitions, manning a bric-a-brac and book stall, etc). **Internal Competitions -** There have been some exciting games played between members during June. personally if they will play. It would be so helpful if people signed up on the lists at the club or on the website, even if it looks as though there are enough names there already. Players do sometimes need to pull out due to illness or injury so it is good to have others in reserve.

**New Shirts -** The new club shirts were delivered in June and all members who have purchased one have commented on how much of an improvement they are compared to the old ones. Everyone's video clip was analysed individually by a coach who pointed out good practice and also made suggestions for improvement.

This has proven to be a real bonus on the hot match days when people are desperate for something refreshing to help cool themselves down at the end of a match.
